Carmarthen Town Council has funding from the Shared Prosperity Fund to assess the opportunities for energy projects in the town.

Community Energy organisations Ynni Sir Gâr and Ynni Teg have been appointed to undertake free site assessments, identify specific measures and develop a plan for action.

To apply, complete the expression of interest form below.

What you can expect:

- An assessor will survey your site with you to assess the building and review energy use, patterns of use etc.
- This information will be turned into an energy report with recommendations to improve efficiency and save money.
- Your assessor can talk you through the report to make sure it is suitable and fully understood.

To be eligible for a free appraisal you will need to:

- Be based in Carmarthen town.
- Own, or have long enough lease, to make energy management of the building worthwhile.
- Have a named person that is willing to be the point of contact.
- Be available this spring/summer to take part.
- Have a back history of at least 12 months of energy bills available.

Timetable:

Site surveys must be completed in Spring/Summer 2024.

Places are limited, so please send in your expression of interest as soon as possible.

Outcomes:

- Your energy report will help you make decisions about how to manage your property and its energy consumption. Whilst there may be some 'quick no cost wins' there may also be steps to take that will require investment. We'll highlight any available funding to help with this.
- The results of all the reports completed for this project will be used by the Town Council to apply for further funding to support delivery.
